2014 Cats in the Community Program Description

Cats in the Community is a university based community outreach program designed to transform a not-for-profit organization's building space using volunteers in one day. This year's project encompasses both indoor and outdoor projects.

Painting

- Volunteers will prepare and paint interior and exterior walls in the lobby, cafeteria, multi-purpose room, and several areas.

Carpentry

- Carpentry projects include building picnic tables, benches, basic wood shelving and cabinets.

Mosaic Murals

- A large mosaic mural will be installed outdoors.

Landscaping

- Xeriscape landscaping will be installed in the rear of the school, including surface preparation, and planting of specific plants. There will also be some landscaping enhancements to the front entrance of the school.

Special Projects

- Murals will be created throughout the site.
- Signage will be installed in the hallways and also on chain link fencing.
- Clean-up and organization of classrooms, supply areas and general grounds.
- Installation of family ceramic tiles on cement benches.

Special note: The projects noted above may require use of a variety of tools and equipment. The projects may also entail lifting, bending and climbing.
